Submission Guidelines

Submission Period: Saturday, June 1, 2024 – Wednesday, December 25, 2024

■ Eligibility: Anyone with a disability, from children to adults, can apply.

■ Entry Fee: Free

■ Number of Entries: Approximately 500 works

■ Categories ①Free category

②Theme category "sustainable society"

Types of Works:

Two-dimensional works such as paintings

Three-dimensional works such as ceramic objects

Please submit works that showcase your free sensibility.

Two-dimensional works should be framed and within 910mm x 727mm (F30 size).

Frames should be equipped with hooks and wires for hanging.

If framed, please use acrylic panels or none, not glass.

Important Notes:

• Only one work per person.

• Works that have won awards in similar contests in the past cannot be submitted.

• The work must be the original work of the applicant.

• The copyright of the submitted work belongs to the applicant. However, the rights to photographs or replicas of the work can be used freely by the organizer for promotional purposes (such as on websites or social media), as well as for creating catalogs and reports.

• Applicants are responsible for the delivery, display, and removal of their works. The organizing body is not responsible for any damage.

After the exhibition period, works can be picked up by the applicants or sent back at their expense.

• Donations of works for management and storage by the organizing body are welcome.

• Three-dimensional works should be within 1000mm x 1000mm x 1000mm and light enough to be carried by one person. Materials are free, but living organisms, perishable items, and dangerous works are not allowed.
